

Neither the Canadian Belgian Horse Association or its Officers, Directors, Members or employees shall be liable for any damages sustained by the applicant for registration or any other person or party as a result of the issuance, transfer or cancellation of registration certificates based upon statements made or information supplied by the applicant for registration or any other person or party.

The Registry will refuse to register any animal if such registration is deemed detrimental to the object of the Registry as stated in its Constitution and By-Laws.

Before sending in registrations to be processed at the CBHA Office, check and make sure the following items are completed and included:

- All areas of the registration application are filled in. Including Owner, Breeder and Stallion Owner's signatures.
- All dates are correct (breeding dates, birth date and castration date)
- Diagram and markings, including body colour and mane and tail colour, completed below.
- Fees must accompany all applications (see fee schedule at <http://canadianbelgianhorse.com/certificatesforms.html>)

All FILLIES born after 2018 are required to be DNA tested at time of registration. Submit registration & DNA fee.

NOTE: The owner of the Dam at the time of the offspring's birth is the first owner of the offspring and the only person that is allowed to register the foal with the CBHA.

Marking Instructions If the color changes gradually (blended) the legs are considered light. If there is a definite line where the color changes this location is to be indicated by checking the appropriate box and drawn on the diagram below.



GUIDE FOR MARKING LEGS


 1--Hoof 2--Coronet 3--Heel 4--Fetlock 5--Knee 6--Hock
